

October 17, 2022

The Jasper City Board of Education met on October 17, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. at the central office conference room. Members present were Willie Moore, Walker Wilson, Scott Thornley, Teresa Sherer, and Mary Beth Barber. Superintendent Dr. Ann Jackson was also in attendance.

Chairperson Willie Moore called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. with the first item to be approved being the agenda. A motion to approve the agenda was made by Teresa Sherer, and a second given by Scott Thornley. The motion carried unanimously.

Chairperson Moore called for a motion to approve the September 26, 2022 board minutes. A motion to approve the board minutes was made by Walker Wilson, a second by Mary Beth Barber, and the motion carried unanimously.

The Superintendent recommended adoption of a motion to approve the following personnel actions:
